

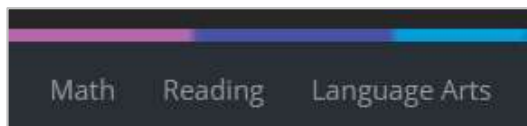


## Edit a Student's Learning Path Placement

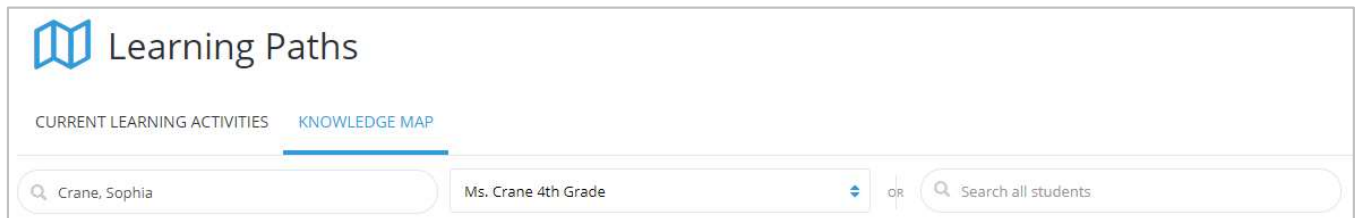
Editing a student's learning path placement allows you to adjust the student's learning path grade level in one or more domains. You may want to do this if you see a student struggling with a skill and believe he or she would be more appropriately placed at a lower grade level. On the other hand, you can also do this to challenge students who would be better placed at a higher grade level.

**Editing a student's learning path placement deletes any previous work the student has completed in the skills or domains you edit.**

1. Select the subject you want to edit.



2. Under **Learning Paths**, click **Knowledge Map**.
3. If you teach multiple classes, select the class from the drop-down, or search for the student's name in the search bar.



4. Click the student's name in the Knowledge Map.  
The student's summary report opens in a new tab.
5. Scroll down to the **Learning Path** heading, and click **Edit Learning Path Placement**.





The **Skill Placement for New Learning Path** window opens.

6. Edit the student's learning path as needed, and click **Save Skill Placement Changes**.  
The **Save Skill Placement Changes** window opens.

7. Click **Yes, Save Learning Path**.
